

## Adam Hull Jr.

Adam Hull the third son of Adam and Elizabeth (Adams) Hull was born at Mt Crawford South Australia on the 21st of September 1856.



Adam married an aboriginal woman Ruby of the Arabunna tribe at Oodnadatta. They had one son Bill, many of his descendants reside in the Port Augusta area. Adam died in the Oodnadatta Hostel (hospital) aged 80 years 9th of November 1935 willing 933 Pounds to his brother's and sister's and their descendants.

Adam was raised in the Mt Crawford, Springton, South Rhine Area, learnt about sheep at Jack Murray's sheep stud and later went north to Strangway Springs and Warrina stations spent many shearing in sheep stations in the area. Adam had a small shop the at the Warrina railway station that he traded some goods. The local Aborigines would trade some gold dingo, scalps and old bones for some of his goods, flour, sugar tobacco and the like.
