

James Hull 1869-1933



James Hull, youngest Son of Adam Hull and Elisabeth [Adams] Hull. Born Mt Crawford South Australia 3.8.1869. Educated at schools in South Rhine and Springton. Was trained as a sheep handler on Jack Murray's sheep Stud at Mount Crawford. Such as breeding culling Shearing and wool classing. Later he joined the South Australian Railways as a Porter stationed at Peterborough and later at Port Pirie.

Married Jessie Florence Carter Potts on the 20 of March 1889 at St.Peter's Church Orroroo South Australia. [We assume James was working at Peterborough at this time and met Jessie while working on the line]. All their South Australian children were born at Eurelia [We presume at the Potts Farm at West Eurelia] except for Jessie Florence who was at Port Pirie on 21 June 1895.

After James Potts died in 1894 the Potts family decided to sell their properties and move to Western Australia where the rainfall was much higher and more regular. The Potts family went to the Narrogin area and James and Jessie to Collie and then to Darkan.

Linda Violet Hull and James Murray Hull, Murray as he was known were both born in Western Australia Linda at Springfield near Darkan and Murray at Collie.

James and Jessie bought land at Darkan on the Duranilling Rd where they established their sheep stud "Linda vale" where they raised merino and corriedale sheep.

Police gazettedated May 2, 1883

A warrant has been issued for James Hull, at Springton, as an uncontrollable child. He decamped from his home during the night of the 17th ultimo, taking with him his clothes, an opossum - skin rug, and a cattle dog. Description :- age 13 yrs, height 5 ft, stout build, fair complexion, grey eyes, short hair; wore grey felt hat, dark coat and waistcoat, and moleskin trousers - (C.945.)

Police Gazette dated October 24, 1883

James died at Linda Vale in 1933.
